Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for families in our congregation and for our young adults and children who find themselves in times of struggle in a complex world, and who feel it hard to find peace within themselves.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for International Children's Day 1 June 2024. We pray for children among us, around us and across the world. Church Council recently sought advice from the ACT Government on their requirements in those instances. We continue to welcome parents attending Oasis to support their child. However, based on that advice, we ask that unless you hold a Working With Vulnerable People's card, you limit your support to just your child.
