Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for our playgroup, boys brigade and girls brigade- for their leaders and helpers. We give thanks for the way these groups support children and parents in the wider community. We pray for Oasis & Billabong groups and their leaders as they begin a new term. We pray for others who might be interested in leading and working with our children.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for O'Connor Uniting Church. Please pray for God's blessing and guidance as the church moves forward and for its role in the community; for the health of the congregation, especially those who are unwell. Pray for God's blessing on the Tongan congregation, the Canberra Monaro Emmaus Community, community groups who hire our premises, the Canberra Organic Growers Society members who use the church grounds for a community garden, and on the people we support locally and overseas; and for God's blessing and direction for our office manager, we give thanks for him and his enabling work.
- This week we join with the World Council of Churches in praying for Republic of Congo, Gabon, Sao Tome and Principe. We are thankful for wildlife and rainforests in these lands, and those who protect this habitat and for the oral traditions, folklore, and good practices that have been preserved. We pray for democratic fair elections and political stability in this region and the witness of the churches and other faith groups in the midst of the challenges.

July Church Council Meeting Summary

- Kelly Dodd, GUC's book keeper for the past 5 years, has tendered her resignation. She will remain in the position until the end of July to ensure a smooth transition to Benkorp (book keeping service).
- CC endorsed the 2024/25 budget, which will be presented to the congregation for approval at the Congregational Budget Meeting on Sunday 18th August.
- As part of GUC's Family and Young People's Ministry Plan, CC has agreed to commence
 the 'Growing Young' program. This program provides a starting place for us to reflect,
 discern and take steps towards being a church that attracts and keeps young people in our
 church, while growing a healthy and thriving cross-generational congregation. 'Growing
 Young' will be supported by the Synod Pulse Team and will be presented to the
 congregation on Sunday 25 August.
- Synod's Uniting Mission and Education and Canberra Region Presbytery will be hosting a Kids/Youth event at Kippax Uniting Church on Friday 23 August. Details are in the bulletin.
- Next CC meeting is Monday 12 August.

There will be a congregational meeting after worship on Sunday 18th August to consider the proposed 2024/2025 church budget.


Church Contact Directory
