Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for those among us who are anxious about their health, that they will know God's peace.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for Missional Initiatives and Collaborative Projects. We give thanks for the Dwelling Together events from 22-25th August. This collaboration between Uniting Mission and Education and the Canberra Region Presbytery. We pray for the potential planting of new faith communities, including the initiative being explored in the Molonglo Valley, ACT. We pray for those who will form and nurture these new expressions of church and for the communities they will serve. We give thanks for the numerous initiatives all over the Canberra Region Presbytery; some new and grassroots, others long-established, others somewhere in between. We pray for new initiatives to continue to spring up, as the needs of communities' shift, the nature of church moves and the way of the world changes
- This week we join with the World Council of Churches in praying for Cape Verde, The Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Senegal. We pray for those people in these societies who continue to live in abject poverty; for an end to policies, systems, and cultural practices that continue to exploit and marginalize some groups; for the fair election of more just government leaders who respect the rights of all people; and for faith communities witnessing and working together for the common good.
