- This week we pray for those who are pondering their nomination for Church Council, and for our AGM which is not just a meeting, but a reflection on our life as a church and directions for the future.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for the Annual Presbytery Minister's Retreat. Each year, the ministry agents (ministers, pastors, candidates, chaplains) of the Canberra Region Presbytery retreat to build relationships, support and learn from one another, and connect more deeply with God. We pray for safety as the ministry agents travel to and from the retreat. We pray for rest, encouragement and renewal for ministry agents in need. A few weeks ago, the Gungahlin Uniting Church congregation was invited to write the word 'Welcome' on a card in their own language. All those cards are now hanging on the wall in the church. Did you know that our friends in this church speak at least 17 different languages at home with their family? On the Sunday when we wrote 'Welcome', half of us wrote in English and half of us wrote in another language. We speak Cantonese, Mandarin, German, Korean, Indonesian, Swahili, French, Arabic, Fijian, Hindi, Urdu, Welsh, Japanese, Sinhala, Albanian, Sierra Leone Creole and English. Some of us can also speak or read some Spanish, Italian, Greek, Portuguese and Papua New Guinea Tok Pisin.

We are part of a wonderful, colourful and diverse world. If your language is missing, ask Alison Tweedie at the church office how you can add it.
