Our Church at Prayer...

Inviting you to think about our own church community, the wider church, the world!

- This week we pray for those around us who grieve and who are feeling the weight of life, love, family, death at this time. Bianca Master's father passed away last week, and the family held a family memorial service last Thursday. Please remember Bianca, her mum, and their extended family in your prayers.
- This week we join the Canberra Region Presbytery in praying for Braidwood Uniting Church. Prayer items from Rev Graham Long: The church just bought a caravan for a lady who is sleeping under the bridge over the Shoalhaven River. She has a 13-year-old boy sleeping on the ground. We started him in school last week having been absent for several years. Thankfully he's joined a class interested in agricultural studies and he's loving spending time with some cows. Rental is not possible in this complex situation but for now, both mum and boy are sleeping in a bed!. We've funded a couple of major car repairs recently. People can't get to the shops or doctors when they live out of town. We helped a lady run away from home. She had 3 kids in their 20's who wouldn't go to work to help their mother with rent and expenses, so she ran away. We funded the escape and paid the back rent on the old house and the bond on the new flat. Every week we pray, "We bless your poor that they might be lifted up". We're doing our best to lift some people up.
- This week we join with the World Council of Churches in praying for Ireland; United Kingdom: England, Northern Ireland, Scotland, Wales. We give thanks for the economic and other aid that consistently have come from the area to those in the world who are most in need. We pray for resolving differences and political tensions over how Great Britain should relate to the rest of Europe; and for dealing with the challenges of increasing secularism and the emergence of new ways of expressing religion and spirituality.


